A motion was made by Hines seconded by Wampler to approve the closure of Broadway from C Street to Pike Street December 3, 2015 from 6:15 P.M until 8:00 P.M. for the Lenoir City Christmas Parade. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Shields, Simpson and Wampler Voting AYE. Johnson absent.
