Vice-Mayor Simpson asked for comments from citizen regarding an item/items on the agenda.

A motion was made by Johnson and seconded by Shields to approve the minutes of the March 12, 2018 meeting. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Johnson, Shields, and Wampler voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Shields and seconded by Wampler to adopt a Resolution requesting the Loudon County Election Commission to hold a City Election. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Johnson, Shields, and Wampler voting **AYE**.
