The City Council of Lenoir City met in a Public Hearing at 5:50 P.M. and 5:55 P.M. The purpose of the 5:50 P.M. public hearing was to adopt an Ordinance for the Annual Budget for the General Fund, State Street Aid Fund, Community Development Fund, Downtown VIP Fund, Sanitation Fund, Capital Projects I Fund, Stormwater Utility Fund, Lenoir City DEA Fund, and Lenoir City State Drug Fund for the Fiscal year Beginning July 1, 2018 and ending June 30, 2019. The 5:55 P.M. public hearing was to adopt an Ordinance for the Annual Budget for Lenoir City Schools for General Purpose Fund, Sales Tax Fund, Federal Projects Fund, and Food Service Fund beginning July 1, 2018 and ending June 30, 2019. Following the public hearings City Council met in its regularly scheduled meeting at 6:00 P.M. Mayor Aikens and the following Council Members were present: Henline, Hines, Simpson, and Wampler. Amber Scott-Kelso, Gregg Harrison, and Maggie Hunt were also present. Councilman Johnson and Councilman Shields were absent.
