The City Council of Lenoir City met in its regularly scheduled meeting on Monday, February 28, 2022 at 6:00 P.M. Mayor Aikens and the following Council Members were present: Henline, Hines, Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson. Amber Scott, Gregg Harrison, Jim Wilburn, and Maggie Hunt were also present.

A motion was made by Shields and seconded by Wampler approving the minutes of the January 24, 2022 City Council meeting. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

Mayor Aikens asked for comments from citizens regarding an item/items on the agenda.

A motion was made by Shields and seconded by Wampler to adopt an Ordinance providing a Plan of Services for certain properties proposed for annexation into the City of Lenoir City by Ordinance, Pursuant to §6-51-102 of Tennessee Code Annotated, said property being approximately five (5) acres located at 1120 and 1400 Pine Top Street, furthermore, identified as Loudon County Control Tax Map 15M, Group D, Parcels 1.00 and 2.00 being located within the Lenoir City Urban Growth Boundary. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**.
First Reading.

A motion was made by Henline and seconded by Wampler to adopt an Ordinance to amend the Zoning Map of the City of Lenoir City, Tennessee pursuant to §13-7-204 of Tennessee Code Annotated, to rezone property located 1451 Highland Park Drive from C-3 Highway Commercial District to R-2 Medium Density Residential District. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

First Reading.

A motion was made by Brandon and seconded by Shields to approve the street closure of Depot Street for the Loudon County Chamber of Commerce Business Expo event on May 13, 2022 with closure from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM, with a potential "rain date" of May 20, 2022 The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

A motion was made by Henline and seconded by Simpson to adopt a Resolution requesting the Loudon County Election Commission to hold a City Election on November 8, 2022. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Hines, Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**.


Mayor Aikens asked for comments from citizens regarding an item/items not on the agenda.
