The City Council of Lenoir City met in a Public Hearing of a Special-Called City Council Meeting on Monday, June 20, 2022 at 2:50 P.M. The purpose of the Public Hearing was for Ordinance to establish certain guidelines when elected to any City Offices. Following the Public Hearing, City Council met in a Special Called City Council meeting at 3:00 P.M. Mayor Aikens and the following Council Members were present: Henline, Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson. Hines was absent. Amber Scott Kelso, Maggie Hunt, and LaVonne Barbour were also present.

Mayor Aikens asked for comments from citizens regarding an item/items on the agenda. Lenoir City Schools Superintendent Dr. Jeanne Barker spoke on Agenda Item #1.

A motion was made by Henline and seconded by Wampler to adopt Ordinance to establish certain guidelines when elected to any City Offices. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**. Hines was **Absent**.

A motion was made by Simpson and seconded by Brandon to adopt Ordinance for the Annual Budget for the General Fund, State Street Aid Fund, Community Development Fund, HOME Program Fund, Downtown VIP Fund, Sanitation Fund, Stormwater Utility Fund, Capital Projects I Fund, Capital Projects II Fund, ARPA (American Rescue Plan Act) Funds, Lenoir City DEA Fund, and Lenoir City State Drug Fund for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2022 and ending June 30, 2023. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**. Hines was **Absent**. **First Reading.**

A motion was made by Henline and seconded by Wampler to adopt Ordinance to provide Revenue for the Municipality of Lenoir City, County of Loudon, Tennessee for Property Tax Year 2022. A motion was made by Wampler and Seconded by Brandon to adopt Ordinance for General Purpose Fund the Annual Budget for the Lenoir City Schools Fiscal Year Beginning July 1, 2022 and ending June 30, 2023. A motion was made by Simpson and Seconded by Henline to adopt Ordinance for Sales Tax Fund the Annual Budget for the Lenoir City Schools Fiscal Year Beginning July 1, 2022 and ending June 30, 2023. A motion was made by Henline and Seconded by Brandon to adopt Ordinance for Federal Projects Fund the Annual Budget for the Lenoir City Schools Fiscal Year Beginning July 1, 2022 and ending June 30, 2023. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**. Hines was **Absent**. **First Reading.**

A motion was made by Shields and seconded by Simpson to adopt Ordinance for Food Service Fund the Annual Budget for the Lenoir City Schools Fiscal Year Beginning July 1, 2022 and ending June 30, 2023. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**. Hines was **Absent**. First Reading.

A motion was made by Shields and seconded by Simpson to adopt Ordinance for Capital Projects Fund for Annual Budget for the Lenoir City Schools Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2022 and ending June 30, 2023. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**. Hines was **Absent**. First Reading.

Mayor Aikens asked for comments from citizens regarding an item/items not on the agenda.


A motion was made by Wampler and seconded by Shields to approve all bills and accounts to be paid when properly approved and funds available. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**. Hines was **Absent**.
