The City Council of Lenoir City met in a Public Hearing on Monday, June 27, 2022 at 5:50 P.M. The purpose of the first Public Hearing was for Ordinance for Annual Budget for the General Fund, State Street Aid Fund, Community Development Fund, HOME Program Fund, Downtown VIP Fund, Sanitation Fund, Stormwater Utility Fund, Capital Projects I Fund, Capital Projects II Fund, ARPA (American Rescue Plan Act) Funds, Lenoir City DEA Fund, Lenoir City State Drug Fund for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2022 and ending June 30, 2023. The purpose of the second Public Hearing was for Ordinance to provide Revenue for the Municipality of Lenoir City, County of Loudon, Tennessee for Property Tax Year 2022. The purpose of the third Public Hearing was for Ordinance approving 2021-2022 Budget Amendments for the General Fund, State Street Aid Fund, Downtown VIP Fund, Sanitation Fund, Stormwater Utility Fund, Capital Projects I Fund, Capital Projects II Fund, ARPA (American Rescue Plan Act) Funds, Lenoir City DEA Fund, and Lenoir City State Drug Fund. The purpose of the fourth Public Hearing was for Ordinance for the Annual Budget for Lenoir City Schools for Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2022 and ending June 30, 2023: General Purpose Fund, Sales Tax Fund, Federal Projects Fund, Capital Projects Fund, and Food Service Fund. Following the Public Hearing, City Council met in its regularly scheduled meeting at 6:00 P.M. Mayor Aikens and the following Council Members were present: Henline, Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson. Hines was **Absent**. Amber Scott Kelso, Maggie Hunt, and LaVonne Barbour were also present.




Mayor Aikens asked for comments from citizens regarding an item/items not on the agenda.
