The City Council of Lenoir City met in a Public Hearing on Monday, July 25, 2022 at 5:50 P.M. The purpose of the Public Hearing was for Ordinance to amend the Zoning Map of the City of Lenoir City, Tennessee pursuant to §13-7-204 of the Tennessee Code Annotated, to rezone portion of property located off Kingston Street from R-2 Medium Density Residential District to C-2 Central Business District. Following the Public Hearing, City Council met in its regularly scheduled meeting at 6:00 P.M.
