

October 24, 2022

The City Council of Lenoir City met in its regularly scheduled meeting on Monday, October 24, 2022, at 6:00 P.M. Mayor Aikens and the following Council Members were present: Henline, Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson. Amber Scott Kelso, Walter Johnson, and James Wilburn were also present. Councilman Hines was absent.

A motion was made by Henline and seconded by Shields approving the minutes of the September 12, 2022 City Council meeting. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**. Councilman Hines was absent.

Mayor Aikens requested the approval to add agenda numbers 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, & 14 to the October 24, 2022, agenda to approve #9 consideration regarding going out for Request for Qualifications for Traffic Signal Maintenance contractor for corporate limits; #10 regarding closure of First Avenue from North C Street to North D Street for Calvary Baptist Church's Truck or Treat event on Monday October 31, 2022; #11 regarding adoption of Ordinance providing a Plan of Services for certain properties proposed for annexation into the City of Lenoir City by Ordinance, pursuant to §6-51-102 of Tennessee Code Annotated, said property being approximately 24.30 acres located off Highway 70, furthermore identified as Loudon County Control Tax Map 009, Parcel 111.00 being located within the Lenoir City Urban Growth Boundary; #12 regarding adoption of Ordinance to amend the Zoning Map of the City of Lenoir City, Tennessee pursuant to §12-7-204 of the Tennessee Code Annotated, to rezone property located off Old Highway 95 from C-3 Highway Commercial District and R-1 Low Density Residential District to R-3 High Density Residential District; #13 regarding accepting a donation of a 2007 Fire Apparatus from the City of Alcoa; and #14 regarding declaring two seized vehicles as surplus property in the Police Department and sell on Gov-Deals. A motion was made by Shields and seconded by Brandon to approve the additions of item numbers 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, & 14 to the October 24, 2022, agenda. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**. Councilman Hines was absent.

Mayor asked for comments from citizens regarding an item/items on the agenda.

Chris Wampler, representing First Baptist Church, addressed the Mayor and City Council on the reasoning the church approved the Loudon County School Board to purchase land located at 6445 Highway 11 East.

Maggie Hunt, Lenoir City Finance Director, addressed the Mayor and City Council regarding the reason Lenoir City Property Tax Notices were late getting to our citizens.

A motion was made by Wampler and seconded by Shields accepting the American Firefighters Grant (AFG) for the purchase of a ladder truck for the Fire Department. The AFG will be \$1,186,900.00 and the City will be responsible for \$192,764.00. The purchase of the Ladder Truck will be with Emergency Vehicle Specialists State Contract #FS12-19. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**. Councilman Hines was absent.

A motion was made by Henline and seconded by Shields regarding declaring certain weapons as surplus property and to purchase other weapons for the Police Department from GT Distributors-Austin (documentation attached as Exhibit A). The following vote was recorded: Henline, Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**. Councilman Hines was absent.

A motion was made by Simpson and seconded by Brandon to approve the permanent full-time employment for Skyler McGinnis, six months probationary period satisfactorily completed effective November 2, 2022. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**. Councilman Hines was absent.

A motion was made by Brandon and seconded by Shields to approve the permanent full-time employment for Christopher Law, six months probationary period satisfactorily completed effective November 10, 2022. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**. Councilman Hines was absent.

A motion was made by Simpson and seconded by Henline adopting a Resolution contracting (de-annexing) property located at 6445 Highway 11 East, containing approximately 27.18 acres, furthermore, identified as Loudon County Tax Map 015, Parcel 151.00 being located within the Corporate Limits of Lenoir City. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**. Councilman Hines was absent.

Resolution-2022-10-24-2343-A.

A motion was made by Shields and seconded by Wampler adopting a Resolution accepting the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Funds via the Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation (TDEC) to be used for drinking water, wastewater, or stormwater projects as deemed appropriate. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**. Councilman Hines was absent.

Resolution-2022-10-24-2343-B.

A motion was made by Simpson and seconded by Shields to approve the Mayoral appointment of Bobby Halcomb to fill the vacancy of Bill Thomas on the Planning Commission and the Board of Zoning Appeals. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**. Councilman Hines was absent.

A motion was made by Brandon and seconded by Simpson to approve granting the employees two (2) hours of time on Thursday, December 22, 2022. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**. Councilman Hines was absent.

A motion was made by Wampler and seconded by Brandon to approve going out for Request for Qualifications for Traffic Signal Maintenance contractor for corporate limits of Lenoir City. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**. Councilman Hines was absent.

A motion was made by Henline and seconded by Shields to approve the closure of portion of First Avenue from North C Street to North D Street for Calvary Baptist Church's Trunk or Treat event on Monday, October 31, 2022 from 5:00 PM to 8:00 PM. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**. Councilman Hines was absent.

A motion was made by Simpson and seconded by Brandon regarding adoption of Ordinance providing a Plan of Services for certain properties proposed for annexation into the City of Lenoir City by Ordinance, pursuant to §6-51-102 of Tennessee Code Annotated, said property being approximately 24.30 acres located off Highway 70, furthermore identified as Loudon County Control Tax Map 009, Parcel 111.00 being located within the Lenoir City Urban Growth Boundary. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**. Councilman Hines was absent.

First Reading.

A motion was made by Brandon and seconded by Wampler regarding adoption of Ordinance to amend the Zoning Map of the City of Lenoir City, Tennessee pursuant to §13-7-204 of the Tennessee Code Annotated, to rezone property located off Old Highway 95 from C-3 Highway Commercial District and R-1 Low Density Residential District to R-3 High Density Residential District. The following vote was recorded: Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**. **Councilman Henline ABSTAINS** from voting, and Councilman Hines was absent.

First Reading.

A motion was made by Shields and seconded by Simpson accepting the donation of a 2007 Fire Apparatus from the City of Alcoa. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**. Councilman Hines was absent.

A motion was made by Henline and seconded by Brandon regarding declaring two seized vehicles as surplus property in the Police Department and sale on Gov-Deals (documentation attached as Exhibit B). The following vote was recorded: Henline, Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**. Councilman Hines was absent.

Mayor Aikens asked for comments from citizens regarding an item/items not on the agenda.


Dr. Jan Hahn addressed the Mayor and City Council regarding his bid for the House District Seat 32 and the excellent work the Mayor and City Council are doing.
