A motion was made by Shields and seconded by Wampler to approve the minutes of the March 13, 2023 meeting. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Kennedy, Wampler, Shields, and Brandon voting **AYE**. Simpson was **ABSENT**.

Mayor Aikens asked for comments from citizens regarding an item/item on the agenda.

A motion was made by Shields and seconded by Henline to approve the Purchasing Committee's recommendation regarding 2022-2023 Paving Contract for APAC-Atlantic, Inc. with the lowest/best bid at \$206,500.00 and pick up at plant with Duracap Asphalt at \$93.50 per ton. 

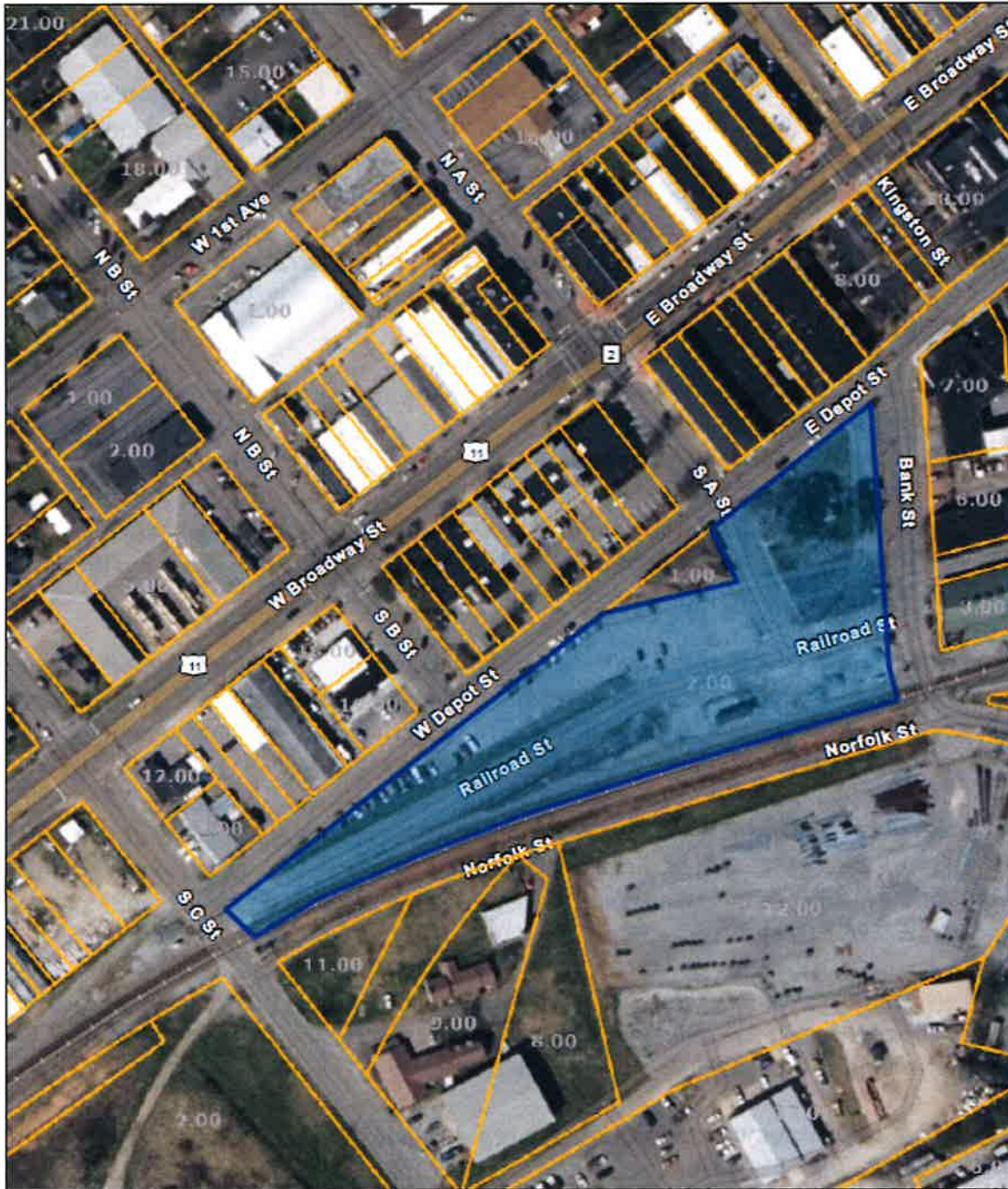

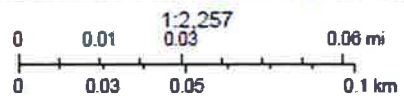
