The Lenoir City Council met in a Public Hearing on Monday, April 10, 2023 at 5:50 P.M. The purpose of the Public Hearing was for Ordinance providing a Plan of Services for certain properties proposed for annexation into the City of Lenoir City by Ordinance, pursuant to §6-51-102 of the Tennessee Code Annotated, said property being approximately 0.39 acres located at Shaw Ferry Road and Highway 321, furthermore identified as Loudon County Control Tax Map 0100, Group B, Parcel 006.00 being located within the Lenoir City Urban Growth Boundary. Following the Public Hearing, City Council met in its regularly scheduled meeting at 6:00 P.M. Mayor Tony Aikens and the following Council Members were present: Henline, Kennedy, Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson. Walter Johnson, James Wilburn, Amber Scott Kelso, and LaVonne Barbour were also present.

A motion was made by Shields and seconded by Brandon to approve the minutes of the March 27, 2023 meeting. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Kennedy, Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**.

Mayor Aikens requested adding an item to the agenda for consideration of declaring Ford F-550 Bucket Truck (VIN: 1FDAF57F3YEC96765) within the Street Department as surplus property and to sell on govdeals.com. A motion was made by Wampler and seconded by Brandon to add the item to the agenda as Agenda Item #3. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Kennedy, Wampler, Shields, Brandon, and Simpson voting **AYE**.


Mayor Aikens asked for comments from citizens regarding an item/items not on the agenda.
