A motion was made by Brandon and seconded by Simpson to give approval to go out to bid for the pick-up of Residential Garbage, Commercial Garbage, and Landscaping and Mowing Operations and to take back the results to the Purchasing Committee. The following vote was recorded: Henline, Kennedy, Wampler, Shields, Simpson, and Brandon voting **AYE**.

The Mayor and City Council went into Executive Session at 6:15 PM.

The Mayor opened the City Council Meeting back to order at 7:34 PM.


Mayor Aikens asked for comments from citizens regarding an item/items not on the agenda.
